Erectile Dysfunction (ED) is a result of poor blood flow to the penis. Due to the narrowing of blood vessels and plaque build up, erections are difficult and sometimes impossible to maintain.

Despite the variety of treatment options available to treat ED, many men still struggle. These other treatment options have an elevated rate of discontinuation and dissatisfaction.

Extracorporeal Shockwave Therapy (ESWT) is clinically proven and does not have the risks, complications, loss of sexual spontaneity or discomfort of pills, injections, pumps, penile implants and surgery.

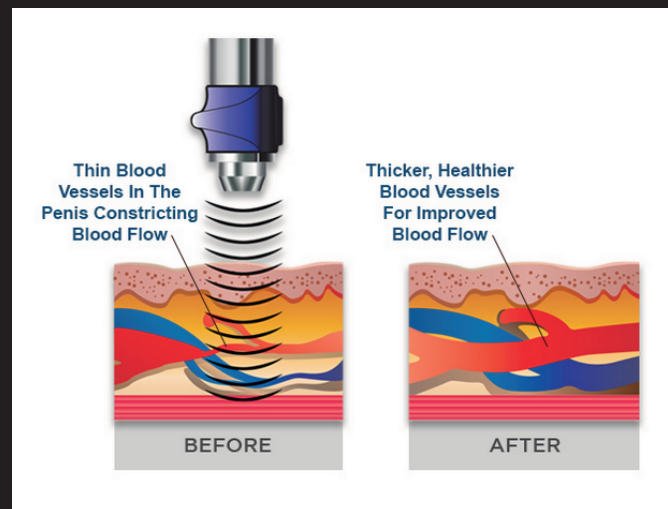
What is ESWT?

ESWT is a highly effective, non-invasive procedure that represents a breakthrough treatment option for erectile dysfunction.

Clinical evidence shows that ESWT generates a significant clinical improvement of erectile function as well as improvement in penile blood flow without any adverse effects.

How does ESWT work?

Extracorporeal shockwaves are delivered to the treatment area, encouraging neovascularization in the penis shaft. This creates new blood vessels in the penile tissue, which enables the patient to achieve and maintain firm erections. ESWT also breaks up plaque formation in existing blood vessels, in turn improving blood flow.



How is the treatment performed?

Coupling gel is applied to the penis to permit acoustic wave transmission. The applicator handpiece is then moved over the penile tissue, releasing focused acoustic shockwaves. Some, but not all, men report a slight discomfort during treatment.

What is the duration of the treatment?

The treatment is performed in ED Clinics of Indiana's office. The treatment session takes approximately 30 minutes and does not require anesthesia. You can return to normal activity immediately following treatment. Generally, 6 treatment sessions are necessary, once per week.

What are the expected results?

After the series of treatments, many patients report:

- Improved erectile function
- Increased stimulation
- Decreased pain
- Improved satisfaction
